**Deposits and Payments:** Please make checks payable to Burkhalter Travel. A deposit of \$250 per person is required to secure reservations. All major credit cards are also accepted. **Final payment is due on or before December 10, 2010.**

**Cancellations, Refunds and Insurance:** Cancellations must be made in writing and are subject to a \$50 service fee. In addition to the service fee, cancellation penalties are as follows:  
Prior to December 10, 2010 - \$50.  
December 10 - January 24, 2011 - \$250.  
January 25 - February 14, 2011 - 50% of gross fare.  
After February 15, 2011 - no refund.
